

About the Competition

A maximum of 20 bands will compete, based on entry and payment postmark. There will be preliminary awards on five class divisions based upon the number of wind & percussion players. Bands may choose to play in a larger classification if they desire, but once a band is entered may not be changed to a lower class.

Classification System

- A = 1-29 winds/percussion
- B = 30-50 winds/percussion
- C = 51 - 69 winds/percussion
- D = 70-105 winds/percussion
- E = 106 + winds/percussion

Preliminary Field Competitions

Trophies awarded for top three bands in each class. Caption awards in each class for Outstanding soloist, percussion, color guard, drum major, Music, Marching and General Effect.

Open Class Final Field Competitions

Finalist bands will be the top ten bands. All finalist bands will receive a trophy. Finals awards will include: Outstanding, percussion, color guard, drum major, Music, Marching and General Effect.
