Field Show Adjudicators



Dr. Martin Dunlap (Music Effect) has worked in education for the past 40 years as a band director, high school assistant principal, consultant, adjudicator, university professor and administrator. He has taught all levels of high school band and orchestra in both small and large high school settings. He served nineteen years as director of the Blue Valley High School band program in Stilwell, KS. His Stridin' Tigers Marching Band at Blue Valley High School had a reputation for innovation and high quality performance. They performed and competed throughout the Midwest and were consistent finalists at Bands of America Regional Championships. The Symphonic

Bands at BVHS received numerous awards as well as consistent first division ratings at state music festivals, and were regular performers at Kansas Music Educators Association Workshops.

Since his retirement from band directing, Martin works as an education consultant in music, online education, online course development and school improvement initiatives with teachers and administrators. He adjudicates both concert and marching bands throughout the Midwest.

He has earned a BA degree from MidAmerica Nazarene University, a M.M. Ed. and Ed. D. in Education Administration from the University of Kansas, and is a member of several professional organizations.



Dr. Craig Fuchs (Visual Ensemble) is Professor of Music, Director of the Honors College, and Director of the Bachelor of General Studies Program at Pittsburg State University. Dr. Fuchs holds degrees in music education from Missouri Western State University and the University of Missouri-Columbia. He holds a Doctorate of Musical Arts in Wind Conducting from the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory of Music. Dr. Fuchs had ten years of teaching experience in the public schools of Kansas and Missouri prior to moving to the collegiate level.



Jared Brockmeyer (Visual Effect) is a St. Louis-based designer, teacher, and adjudicator.

A marching member of the Colts Drum and Bugle Corps from 1999 – 2002, Jared spent the next several years on the visual staff serving in various capacities from technician to caption head. Shortly following his move to St. Louis, Jared assumed the role of visual designer and caption head for the Rockwood Summit High School Marching Band from 2009 – 2013. During his tenure Rockwood Summit rose from local competitor to finalist in two BOA regionals, class champions at another, and placed 11th in visual at the BOA St. Louis Super Regional. Jared is an active judge

throughout the state and has designed for several schools in and around the St. Louis area.

Jared is a graduate of Truman State University where he received his B.A. in Education, M.A. in Music, and M.A. in Education. He is in his final year of National Board certification.

Jared is currently serving in his 7th year as assistant director at Rockwood South Middle School (Fenton, Mo) where he teaches beginning horn, beginning trombone, and 7th Grade band.

Jared lives in Ellisville with his wonderful wife Sara and daughters Eliza and Fiona. He is an endurance athlete, mains a Warlock when battling The Darkness, and makes burgers and pizza that will melt your face off.



Dr. Scott Tomlison (Music Ensemble) Dr. Scott Tomlison is Associate Professor of Music and Coordinator of Music Education at the University of Arkansas-Fort Smith. His duties include supervising student teachers, teaching methods courses, applied trumpet, and conducting the Brass Ensemble.

Prior to his appointment at UAFS, Dr. Tomlison was the Coordinator of Music Education and Chair of the D'Angelo Department of Music at Mercyhurst University in Erie, Pennsylvania. His responsibilities included teaching instrumental conducting, music education courses, and conducting the Mercyhurst Symphony Orchestra. He taught public school music for a total of nine years, including appointments at Poplar Bluff High School (Missouri), Gallatin Co. High School (Kentucky), Grant Co. High School (Kentucky), and Miami East High School (Ohio).

In addition to his Mercyhurst appointment, his previous collegiate experience includes Director of Bands at McPherson College and Manchester University. Dr. Tomlison has also served as Assistant Conductor of the University of Missouri Wind Ensemble and Concert Band, as well as drill writer for "Marching Mizzou" and the Murray State University Marching Band. While at Missouri and Murray State, Dr. Tomlison was active as a jazz performer and conducted the second and third jazz ensembles at both institutions. In 1985 and 1986 he marched with the drum corps, *Star of Indiana*, and became Brass Instructor and Brass Caption Head with *Limited Edition* from Columbus, Ohio (1989-1991). Most recently, he has served on the brass staff of the *Music City Drum and Bugle Corps* from Nashville, Tennessee (2011), *7th Regiment Drum and Bugle Corps* from New London, Connecticut (2014-2017) and *Louisiana Stars Drum and Bugle Corps* from Lafayette, Louisiana.

His research interests include using recordings as models in the rehearsal setting, concert program development, and ensemble grading practices. Dr. Tomlison has presented sessions on these important topics at several state and regional music education conferences. He is the co-author of the Middle School Band Edition of *Teaching Music Through Performance in Band*. The volume was published in December of 2014. Dr. Tomlison has served as adjudicator/clinician in Kentucky, Indiana, Ohio, Illinois, Missouri, Tennessee, Kansas, New York, Pennsylvania, West Virginia, Oklahoma, and Arkansas. He has twice been named to Who's Who in America and Who's Who in Collegiate Faculty. He holds a B.M.E. Degree from Eastern Kentucky University, an M.M.E. degree from Murray State University, and a Ph. D. in Curriculum and Instruction from the University of Missouri-Columbia. His professional affiliations include Arkansas Music Educators Association, National Association for Music Education, Cavalcade of Bands, Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association and Phi Mu Alpha.



Adam Hall (Indoor and Field Percussion) Adam Hall is a native of Hermann, MO and has been a band director in the Pattonville School District (St. Louis) since 2008. He is an alumni of the University of Missouri-Columbia for both his Bachelors in Music Education and Masters in Percussion Performance. His percussion experiences have been guided by Julia Gaines and Nathan Spurling at Mizzou, Chris Hestin as a member of the Glassmen Drum and Bugle Corps, and countless other colleagues in the music world. Since 2005, Adam has regularly traveled the country as a member of the Central States Judges Association, judging percussion, music ensemble, and music general effect. He has also served a variety of roles in the Mid Continent Color Guard Circuit for both percussion and color guard. From 2010-2016, Adam served as one of the Vice Presidents for the St. Louis Suburban Music Educator's Association coordinating the St. Louis County Middle School Honor Band. Sheri Harris (Indoor/Field Auxiliary) Sheri Harris has been involved with and passionate about the "Sport of the Arts" for twenty-seven (27) years. She performed 3 seasons and then instructed throughout the existence of the Sky Ryders Independent Winter Guard program. Sheri also marched with the Boston Crusaders Drum & Bugle Corps in 1999. In 1998, she began instructing color guards in Missouri, Iowa and Nebraska. Most recently, Spring 2018, Sheri retired from her role as Color Guard Director of the Blue Springs Golden Regiment Marching Band and Blue Springs Winter Guard Programs for thirteen (13) years.
